



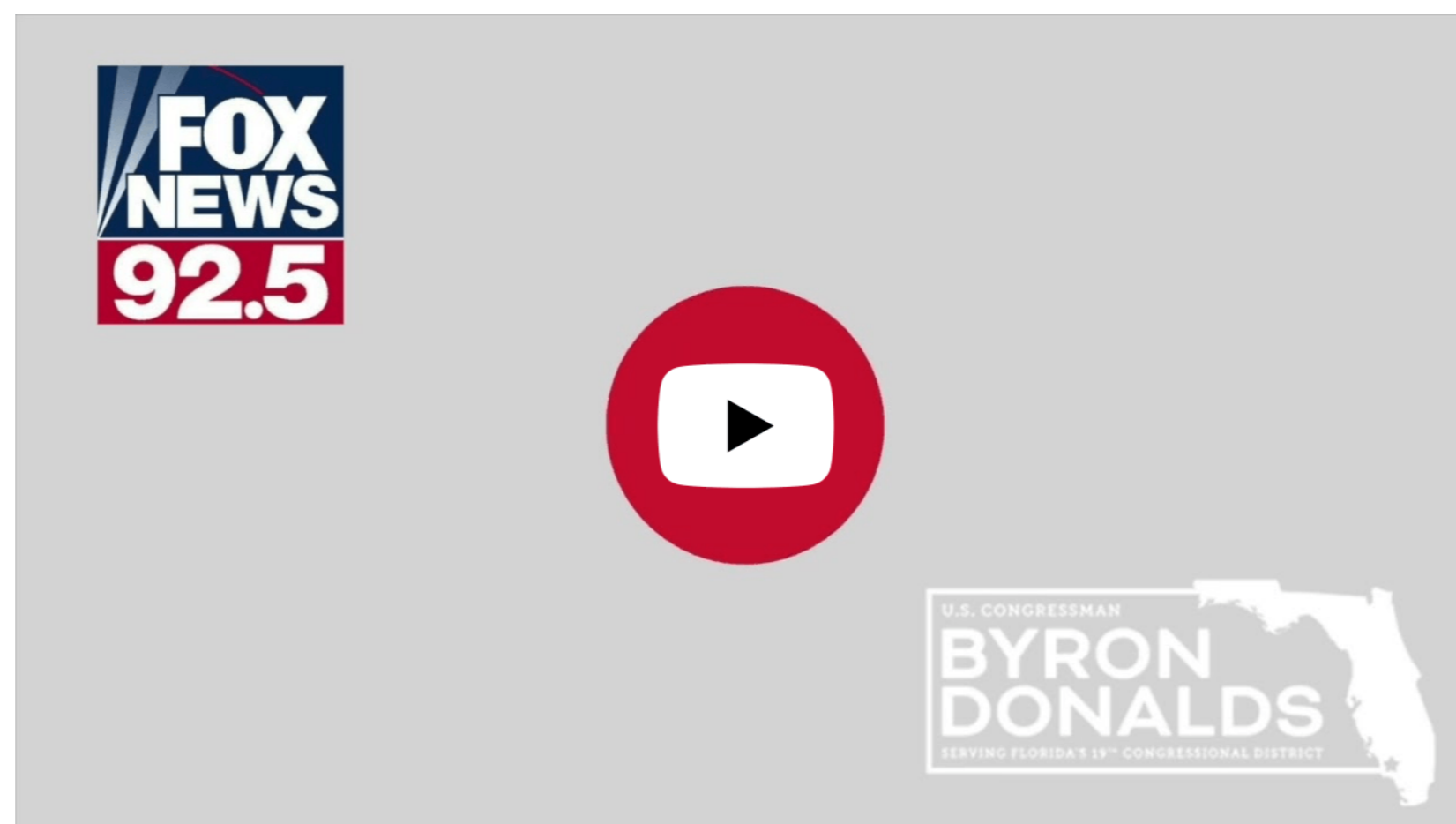

Look, here's where we are, Chuck Schumer was brutally hammered by the radical left when he worked with President Trump, and House and Senate Republicans to keep the government open back in March.
