Donalds Meets With Lee County Officials At Emergency Operations Center As Hurricane Season 2025 Progresses

FORT MYERS, Fla. – As Hurricane Season 2025 bears down on the Sunshine State, Congressman Byron Donalds (R-FL) met with Lee County officials in Fort Myers for a site-visit of recent upgrades to Lee County’s Emergency Operations Center.
