That was Democrats that voted for Joe Biden's economic plan, which led to higher inflation for the American people, a stagnant economy, wages adjusted for inflation were down, and they're going to rebrand themselves? He wants more natural gas again to decrease energy prices in the United States for the American people. But when you look at the dollar differences between the party, I think a lot of people are saying that Democrats don't have real answers. They might try to throw a new personality out there, but that's not the policy that's really going to matter. As far as Republicans are concerned, we have to continue to embrace President Trump's agenda, get it passed through Congress, [and] make sure that the policies begin to get enacted in our country so the American people can fully see the difference between Republicans and Democrats.
