The rules are good for everybody else but not for her:

“Well my first reaction is, I mean, how come you got security money? And look, I want every member of Congress to be safe, let me first say that. But, you are spending security money. I mean, I don’t have security money. I am not spending on it and a lot of my colleagues don’t, male or female, that is number one. Number two, again, like you said, the rules are good for everybody else but not for her. She wants to be protected at all times, but, she is leaving so many of her fellow citizens basically at the lurch of criminals where there is no police around. Third part is, you know, they are quick to try to defame President Trump on so many of these trumped-up charges; meanwhile, mishandling of funds to the point where the Department of Justice is having to investigate a Democrat official.”

Congress has a responsibility to hold the executive branch accountable:

"Well time is an issue, but, you know, the point I have been making to my colleagues who have some concerns is that Congress has a responsibility to hold the executive branch accountable, regardless of what part of the year you are dealing with. And if we ignore bribery, if we ignore high crimes and misdemeanors because we are concerned with political re-election, then we're not doing our job as members of Congress and I would actually caution and question our members to examine why are they here and why would they continue to serve. We have a responsibility to hold this administration accountable and we need to do that.”
