"Obamacare is a disaster; it is not affordable, and subsidies are not going to fix that problem":

"I think what we should be doing is fixing the mess that the Democrats have created. Obamacare is a disaster; it is not affordable, and subsidies are not going to fix that problem. What will fix it is Democrats waking up to the reality that their healthcare plan has increased costs on every American. It is unaffordable, it doesn't work. These are things, excuse me, Stu, these are things that are common sense, that actually do work on behalf of the American people, but the Joe Biden, Kamala Harris, Nancy Pelosi permanency standard is actually not helping people, and it continues to add more debt and deficits for the American taxpayer."
