



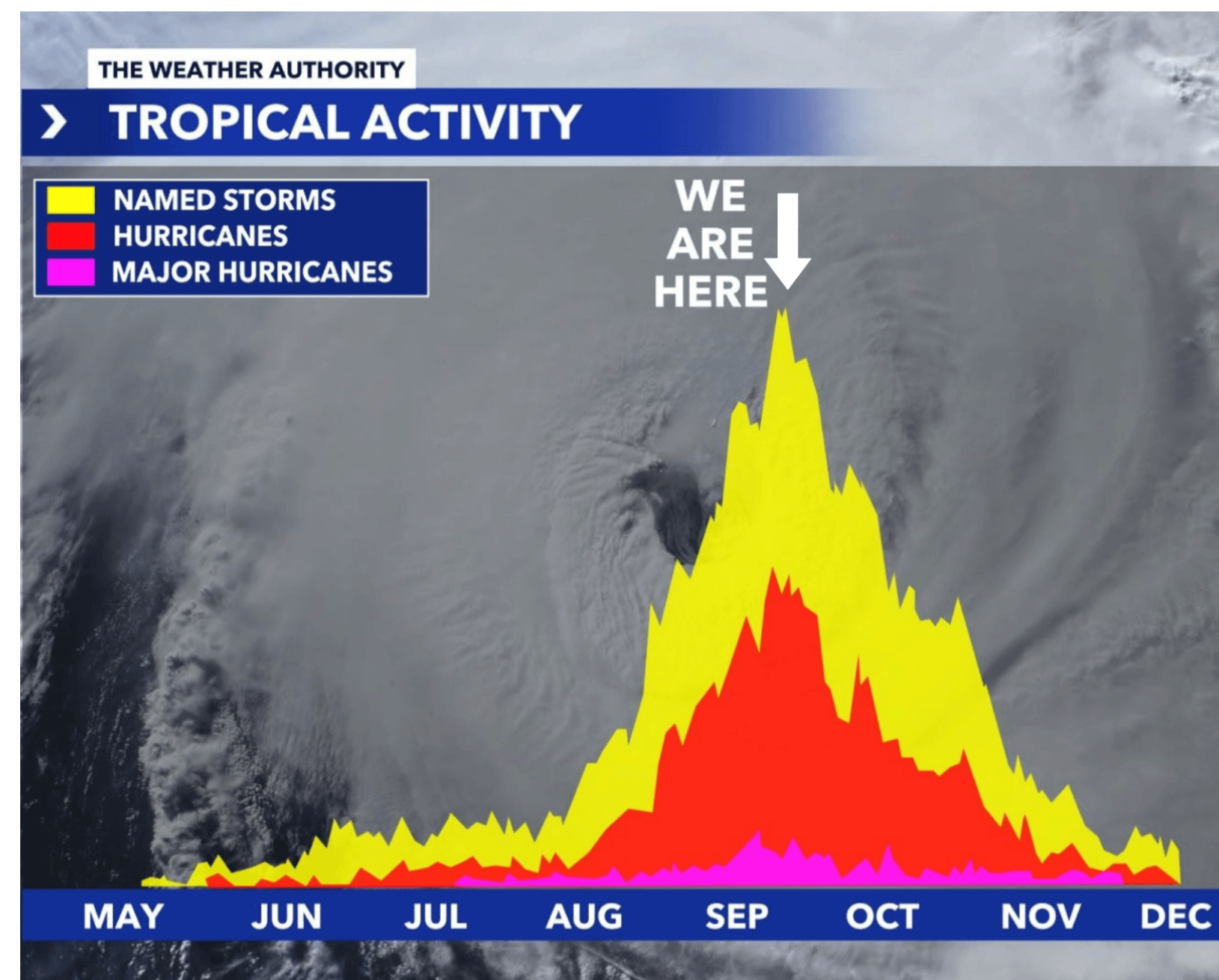

Today Marks Peak Hurricane Season: Donalds Rereleases Important Disaster Preparedness Resources And Information
