To require a report from the Secretary of Homeland Security on the existence of programs and components of the Department of Homeland Security that are not explicitly authorized in statute.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Immigration Author-  
5 ization Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON UNAUTHORIZED PROGRAMS AND COM-**  
2 **PONENTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days, the Sec-  
4 retary of Homeland Security shall submit a report, to the  
5 relevant committees, that identifies each program carried  
6 out by the Secretary under the immigration laws (as such  
7 term is defined in section 101 of the Immigration and Na-  
8 tionality Act) and each component of the Department of  
9 Homeland Security that carries out any duty under the  
10 immigration laws if that program or component is not ex-  
11 plicitly authorized to be carried out for fiscal year 2024  
12 by a statutory provision.

13 (b) RELEVANT COMMITTEES.—For purposes of this  
14 section, the term “relevant committees” means—

15 (1) the Committee on Homeland Security of the  
16 House of Representatives;
