## **Legislative Highlights**

Following Hurricane Ian, It's been my mission to pass much-needed disaster tax relief.
Additionally, I've introduced legislation to bolster economic growth and cut the federal bureaucracy.

Congressman Donalds introduced H.R. 1494, the Hurricane Tax Relief Act, to provide this relief for Southwest Florida and other states and territories impacted by natural disasters.



At a time when our border and sovereignty are vulnerable, and the world is increasingly on fire, I've introduced legislation to address these mounting crises.

Congressman Donalds introduced H.R. 6138, the Reform Immigration through Biometrics Act, to bring critical surveillance of our borders. The Congressman also introduced the Big Biden Blunder (BBB) to demand answers following the devastating withdrawal from Afghanistan.
