4	(a) EVALUATION.—The Director shall evaluate the
5	procurement activities of each agency to determine wheth-
6	er the provisions of section 15.101–2 of the Federal Acqui-
7	sition Regulation have created any national security risk.
8	(b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the en-
9	actment of this Act, the Director shall submit a report
10	on the results of the evaluation under subsection (a) to—
11	(1) the Committee on Oversight and Account-
12	ability of the House of Representatives; and
13	(2) the Committee on Homeland Security and
14	Governmental Affairs of the Senate.
15	(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
